You can do that with DWF viewer. I have used it in the past and works well. But you are on a much better track with Adobe. Plot your layouts to a PDF, and if you get Adobe Pro you can edit the PDF with notes and other info. Your clients can also add notes to the PDF and email them back to you, or they can call you on the phone and you are both looking at the same drawing.

It works like magic.
